The Grignon Mansion in Kaukauna is one of the most historically significant properties in Wisconsin. Built in 1837, this National Register property is owned by the City of Kaukauna and cared for by the Friends of the Grignon Mansion under the oversight of the Grignon Mansion Board.







The Grignon Mansion Board has taken the initiative to create a long-range vision for the preservation, promotion, expansion, and coordination of projects that have an impact on the Grignon Mansion.

In addition to the Mansion, input will be requested on future programs as they relate to historic buildings and sites, regional historic preservation and other activities surrounding historic properties in the City.

Information, data, and leads originating from the visioning workshop will be analyzed by the Board and used to form the nucleus of a long range plan.
